

4 RISKY LOCATIONS FOR PEDESTRIANS

CROSSWALKS

NHTSA found that there are around 500 fatal pedestrian accidents a year in crosswalks. Almost 17% of all accidents occur at 4-way intersections.

ROADSIDES & SHOULDERS

Drivers often do not anticipate pedestrians in areas where there is no sidewalk. (IIHS)

PARKING LOTS

Two-thirds of drivers report distracted driving in parking lots, whether texting, talking on the phone, or using a GPS. (NSC)

SHARED AREAS

Shared areas include spaces where pedestrians and motorists use the same path, such as recreational paths, dirt roads, or places without curbs or sidewalks.

FAST FACTS

75%

of accidents involving pedestrians are in urban areas. (NHTSA)

60%

of nationwide pedestrian deaths in 2021 were on major roads other than interstates and freeways. (IIHS)

93%

of pedestrian fatalities in Portland were accidents that occurred at night. (Portland.gov)
